

Veteran's Benefits

Attention Veteran's or the surviving spouse of a veteran. If you meet the following criteria you may be eligible for Aid and Attendance benefits:

- The veteran would have had to serve at least 90 days of active duty with one of those days being during a recognized period of war.
- The veteran or surviving spouse requires aid of another person in order to perform functions required in everyday living.
- The veteran or surviving spouse must have less than \$80,000.00 in assets excluding primary residence and a vehicle.
- The financial assistance must be spent on out-of-pocket medical expenses.

Aid and Attendance benefits are benefits that are paid in addition to a monthly pension.

The monthly Aid and Attendance benefits for 2009 are:

Single Veteran	up to \$1,644
Surviving Spouse	up to \$1,056
Veteran and Spouse	up to \$1,949
